Candidates for the Sacraments; Women; the Needy  
and Hungry of the World; Penitents and Wanderers

*Notes for Mass and Office during Lent:*

A. Ferial Mass and Readings are proper for each day.  
The seasonal preface is any of the four for Lent.

B. *Alleluia* is omitted from Mass & Office until Easter.

C. All Memorials become optional commemorations.  
If taken, at Mass their opening prayer only is used in  
place of the ferial prayer (cf. n. 24).

D. All are bound to the law of penance. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of complete abstinence and fasting. Those who have completed their 14th year are bound by the law of abstinence; those who have completed their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year are bound by the law of fasting by general church law. Local regulations may differ as to age of obligations.
