Notes for Mass on Ferias of Ordinary Time:

A. At a Ferial Mass, prayers may be taken from any one of the 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time, using one of the six weekday prefaces. The prayers (or even the opening prayer alone) may be taken from an occasional Mass or occasional prayers (see nn. 12-24).

B. The weekday readings during Ordinary Time are of Year II, indicated at the top of each page after the reference to the Sunday readings in the Lectionary.

C. For the celebration of Memorials, see nn. 18-23. For Memorials, the choice of preface includes that of the saint or season, cf. n. 9.
